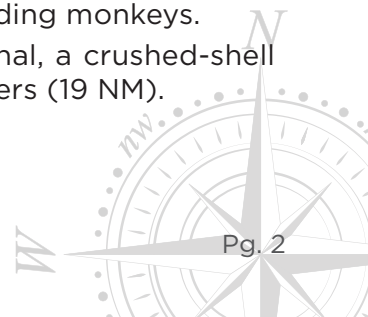
DAY 1

Guests arrive at Liberia International Airport. 25 mins road transfer / 6 mins by helicopter to Marina Papagayo.



DAY 2

- Sunrise at Playa Huevos while listening to the Howler Monkeys.
- Beautiful anchorage spot, surrounded by white sand beaches and green forests.
- Guests enjoy a variety of activities, including: Swimming and snorkelling, watersports, stand up paddle boards, sea kayak.
- Inshore fishing (Mahi Mahi, Roosterfish).
- Surfing at Witches Rock, only 20 minutes from the anchorage and one of the best surf spots in Costa Rica.
- Golf and VIP Spa at the Four Seasons Resort.
- Scuba diving with Eagle Rays, Whitetip Sharks and schooling fish at Monkey's Head.
- Beach BBQ on deserted white sand beaches.
- Tender tour through Mangrove Palmares. These narrow water channels wind between beautiful tall trees and impressive natural scenery.
- Helicopter tour to Rincón de la Vieja National Park - guests can see incredible scenery, waterfalls and wildlife including monkeys.
- Night cruise to Playa Conchal, a crushed-shell sands beach with clear waters (19 NM).

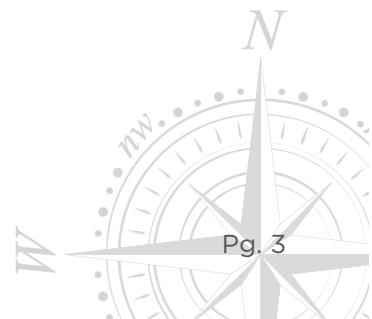




DAY 3

- Sunrise at Playa Zapotal (or Playa Conchal).
- Time for watersports including Jetskis.
- Fishing at Catalina Island (Roosterfish, Mahi Mahi).
- Possible Humpback whale sightings.
- Swimming, snorkeling, kayaking, stand up paddle board.
- Scuba diving at Catalina Islands or at Punta Gorda for beginners.
- Helicopter tour to waterfall Llano de Cortez (1-2hrs).
- Nightlife at Flamingo beach (tender ride) or Tamarindo beach (20 mins by road).

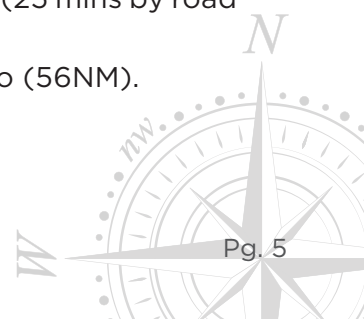
DAY 4

- Sunrise at Playa Conchal (or Playa Zapotal).
- Watersports, Jetskis.
- Diving and snorkeling at Catalina Islands and Widow Rock.
- Possible Humpback whale sightings.
- Swimming, snorkeling, kayaking, stand up paddle boarding.
- Helicopter to Palo Verde National Park, with a river boat tour to see crocodiles, monkeys and birds (2-3hrs).
- Surf class at Tamarindo or Avellana
- Nightlife at Flamingo beach (tender ride) or Tamarindo beach (20 mins by road).
- Night cruise to Isla Tortuga (93NM).



DAY 5

- Wake up at Isla Tortuga.
- The most scenic anchorage in the Central Pacific coast of Costa Rica.
- Watersports, jet skis, SUP.
- Visit Curu - a private Natural Reserve - an easy hike with a naturalist guide to observe forest and wildlife, with possible encounters with monkeys and coatis.
- Morning helicopter tour to Arenal Vulcan area, including a Canopy Tour at Mundo Aventura (forest, waterfalls) and VIP Spa and thermal pools at The Springs Resort (half day, AM only).
- Offshore fishing (Sailfish, Marlin).
- Panoramic tender ride to see incredible geological formations.
- Afternoon swimming, snorkeling and kayaking in the lovely calm waters between the numerous islets around Isla Tortuga.
- Sunset - always an incredible experience!
- Nightlife at Montezuma Beach (25 mins by road from Tambor Beach).
- Night cruise to Manuel Antonio (56NM).





DAY 6

- Day begins at Manuel Antonio, the most popular National Park in Costa Rica.
- Sea kayak and watersports.
- Hike with a naturalist guide into the National Park - primary forest, spectacular beaches, wildlife including iguanas and coaties. (Closed Mondays and busy over the weekend).
- VIP Spa available at 5stars resort.
- Early morning helicopter tour to Pacuare River Canyon, which boasts the most spectacular white water rafting in Costa Rica (3-4hrs).
- Dinner at 5stars restaurant.
- Nightlife at Manuel Antonio bars & discos.
- Night cruise to Drake Bay (40NM).



DAY 7

- Wake up at Drake Bay at the edge of the World Heritage Site, Corcovado National Park.
- Watersports, jetskis, SUP, surfing.
- PM (high tide) sea kayak and snorkel tour through Rio Aguja, a small, uncontaminated clear water river that flows from the heart of rainforest, which will be explained by a local naturalist guide (1hr 30mins - 2hrs).
- Canopy tour and jungle horseback ride, or hike at Rio Claro/San Pedrillo (by tender and short 4x4 ride) Meet monkeys, macaws and wildlife during a spectacular ride down from the hill to a gorgeous pristine beach where the tender will pick you up (3-4hrs).
- Mangrove river tour at Rio Sierpe, the biggest mangrove area in Central America, a labyrinth of wide and small water channels full of life, A naturalist guide will help you understand the inner-workings of this unique ecosystem (rainforest, crocodiles, iguanas, marine and tropical birds).
- Sportfishing (Mahi-mahi, Yellowfin Tuna, Roosterfish, Sailfish).
- Nocturnal jungle walk with naturalist guide (by tender) (glassy frogs, insects, and interesting creepy crawlies!) (2hrs).



DAY 8

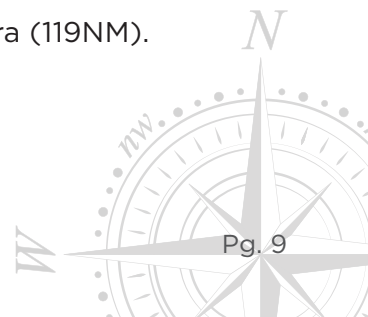
- Morning arrival Isla del Caño, a national Park and marine protected area (13NM).
- Hike Isla del Caño National Park.
- Sea kayak (no jetskis allowed into the National Park).
- Swimming, snorkeling and scuba diving (both advanced and beginner options available) in the Marine Protected Area.
- Offshore Sportfishing.
- "Pelagic Park Dolphins Superpod Experience" with a marine biologist/dolphin expert.
- Snorkel with hundreds of spinner dolphins, bottlenose dolphins or other pelagics 8-20NM offshore by tender. (Spotter plane or helicopter and local skiff required for the search, and dependent on weather conditions).
- Night Cruise to Golfo Dulce (70NM).





DAY 9

- Day begins at a small bay close to Rincon (Golfo Dulce), a beautiful anchorage, inside the only tropical fiord in America, surrounded by high dense green jungle mountains and little islands.
- Watersports, jetskis.
- Sea kayak at Bahia Esquinas.
- Mangrove tour by tender or sea kayak at Rio Esquina.
- Visit the Monkey Sanctuary (by tender) (1hr tour).
- Visit the Botanical Gardens (by tender) with a naturalist guide. The gardens are a wonderful tropical paradise with all sorts of local flora, orchideas and spectacular trees. (1hr 1/2)
- Helicopter tour to Sirena Ranger Station, the Heart of the Corcovado National Park. Hike with a naturalist guide to encounter 70m tall trees, abundant wildlife, four species of monkeys, giant tapir, and more)!
- Night Cruise to Playa Herradura (119NM).





DAY 10

- Sunrise at Playa Herradura (Los Sueños).
- Watersports, jetskis.
- Morning Crocodile Man tour at Tarcoles River (15mins by road). Close encounters with dozens of friendly 5m crocs in their natural habitat (1hr 1/2).
- VIP Spa and golf at Marriot Los Suenos.
- Departure to San Jose International Airport - 25mins by helicopter, or 1hr 30mins by road.
